Subject Request Enter into a Contract Amendment with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety for MnPASS I-394 High Occupancy Toll Lane Enforcement

Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute the State Department of Public Safety, Commissioner of Transportation MnPass I-394 High Occupancy Toll Joint Powers grant contract amendment to accept \$80,000 in funds for toll lane enforcement and request an increase to the general appropriation resolution for 2007 in the amount of \$80,000. The grant award will operate through the state grant fund, 0600-400-DT13, Revenue Source 3215.

The Police Department requests permission to enter into a contract amendment with the Minnesota Department of Transportation for Minneapolis law enforcement services to enforce MnPass I-394 High Occupancy Toll Lane rules and regulations.
