Background/Supporting Information

The Slumberland Furniture Company has offered the Minneapolis Police Department's (MPD) 5th Precinct furniture for the employee lounge. These items, two couches, two end tables, one coffee table, and one table with chairs will replace the no longer serviceable used items the Precinct currently has.
