Approving acceptance of a gift of dog food, treats and towels**

Whereas community member Nancy Williams donated 20 bath towels and linens to the Animal Shelter;

Whereas community member Troy Azzivitto donated Pedigree adult dog food (20 lb), Beneful dog food (4 lb), and four bags of dog treats (Royal Canine, Ol Roy and Professional Brand);

Whereas, Section 465.03 of Minnesota Statutes requires such gift acceptance be made by resolution of City Council, adopted by a two-thirds majority of its members and expressing such terms in full;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by The City Council of The City of Minneapolis:

That Nancy Williams's offer to provide to Animal Care and Control 20 bath towels and linens shall be accepted as a gift on behalf of the City of Minneapolis; and

That Troy Azzivitto's offer to provide to Animal Care and Control Pedigree adult dog food (20 lb), Beneful dog food (4 lb), and 4 bags of dog treats (Royal Canine, Ol Roy and Professional Brand) shall be accepted as a gift on behalf of the City of Minneapolis.
