Background/Supporting Information Attached:

The City of Minneapolis owns and operates many parking ramps in the downtown area. These parking ramps are operated by Municipal Parking Inc. (contracted parking company). In their capacity as parking operator, Municipal Parking also provides security for the parking ramps. These security staff use two-way radios to communicate and respond to incidents and calls. These radio communications have experienced transmission problems due to construction activity in the downtown area. Placing an antenna on the Centre Village building will resolve these problems. Ted Glasrud & Associates (property owners) have agreed to permit this security radio repeater to be located on Centre Village Complex rooftop rent-free with no recurring charges.
