The Minneapolis Police Department requests permission to accept a no-cost grant amendment to the Phillips Weed & Seed Federal grant program for 2006 through the Greater Minneapolis Council of Churches to extend the grant into March 2007 to expend remaining funds. The original grant award of \$73,352 provides overtime or other policing services as deemed necessary to fulfill the goals of the Phillips Weed and Seed program grant.
