## **Finding of Fact, Conclusions, and Recommendations**

This matter came before the License and Consumer Services Division (LCS) during a technical Advisory Committee (TAC) investigation conducted on February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2003 at 1:30 P.M. in Room 1-C of City Hall. Mr. Moss was present as well as deputy Director of Licenses and Regulatory Services, Clara Schmit-Gonzalez and interim Taxicab Inspector, Carl Boeckmann. Also, John Lund, the service manager for Red & White Taxi Co. was present at the hearing. The complainant, Linda Clifford of 2718 Pillsbury Ave. S., was present with her attorney.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Mr. Kevin A. Moss was a licensed taxi driver with the City of Minneapolis on 12-06-02, holding license #L017-29458.
2. Mr. Moss picked up a fare, namely Linda Clifford at 2718 Pillsbury Ave S.
3. When Mr. Moss arrived to pickup Ms. Clifford, Mr. Moss honked the car horn loudly several times. When Ms. Clifford failed to appear right away, he grew impatient
4. When Ms. Clifford came outside to get into the cab Mr. Moss belligerently greeted her and drove the cab in such a manner that she feared for her safety.
5. After a disagreement, Mr. Moss pulled sharply over to the curb at 2917 Pillsbury Ave. and told Ms. Clifford to get out.
6. You failed to file an accurate trip sheet for December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2002 as required by Minneapolis Taxicab Ordinance Section 341.240.

### **CONCLUSIONS**

1. Mr. Kevin Moss acted improperly and his conduct on December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2002, at 9:15 P.M., jeopardized the safety of his passenger, Linda Clifford. Which is in violation of Minneapolis Taxicab Ordinance section 341.120.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

That Mr. Moss serve the penalty below due to the reasons listed.

1. Mr. Moss has already received a fifteen (15) day suspension as a result of the incident.
2. Mr. Moss has an otherwise unblemished record with our office, since his licensure on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2001.
3. Mr. Moss Cooperated in the investigation by providing testimony at his hearing.
4. No further action for or against Mr. Moss is called for at the present time.
