Recommendation:

Acceptance of the low responsive bids as indicated below to furnish and deliver Class A aggregate for bituminous sealcoating as needed through March 2005, as follows:

Dresser Trap Rock, Inc. - for an estimated expenditure of \$ 10,500.00
1. 500 tons Red Seal Coat Chip Aggregate per ton - delivered \$ 21.00

Type of Aggregate: LG Everset, Inc/Ortonville Stone Company

Vendor agrees to allow quantities to be increased up to 100% with no increase in price.

Terms are net 30 days. F.O.B.: Destination.

Martin Marietta Aggregates - for an estimated expenditure of \$ 92,000.00
2. 5,000 tons Gray/Black Seal Coat Chip Aggregate per ton - delivered \$ 18.40

Type of Aggregate: FA-3 Class A (Grey) Granite Aggregate - St. Cloud Quarry

Vendor offers to extend terms and conditions for one (1) additional year after March 31, 2005 at the sole option of the City of Minneapolis.

Vendor agrees to allow quantities to be increased up to 100% with no increase in price.

Terms are net 30 days. F.O.B.: Destination.

Further recommend proper Officers be authorized and directed to execute a contract for this service all in accordance with our specifications.

Tabulation of three (3) bids received on Official Publication No. 6245 for Class A Aggregates for Bituminous Sealcoating is attached.

Per Bid Item #1 (red sealcoat chips): The low bid did not meet the color requirements. The low responsive bid recommendation is Dresser Trap Rock.

Per Bid Item #2 (black/gray sealcoat chips): The bid specs stated that the actual bid award would be based upon a price per ton after a conversion to a price per cubic yard since granite and trap rock materials have different unit weights. Once the calculation was made – the low bid recommendation is Martin Marietta.
