- Practice Manager (PM) has been a big success!!
- Deployed in both Civil and Criminal Division
- Integrated with the State of MN's SIP Court system; ~80% cases automatically created
- Automatic retrieval of available MPD police reports
- Defined Criminal Case Retention Policies


Mode of Operation

- Constantly assessing “integration readiness” of other dependent partnering agencies
- Quickly implementing “low hanging fruit”
 - Jail Booking Document
 - MPD Electronic Citations
- Evaluating the impact of MNCIS
 - New State of MN court system slated to replace Subject In Process (SIP) next summer
 - Hennepin County readiness delayed MCAO

MCAO Core Systems

- Practice Manager (PM) - CMS for *both* Civil and Criminal Divisions
- Stellent / Records Management – Retention of Cases and Legal documents
- XAware – Enterprise Application to Application Integration Tool
- Holding Tank - helps address data quality issues
- Nodonomy – Select data to move to PM


MNCIS is an Opportunity
