**3. Robert DeBoer (Vac-1520, Ward: 3) ([Becca Farrar](#)).**

**A. Vacation:** Application by Robert DeBoer, on behalf of A Chance to Grow, Inc., to vacate the following right-of-way:

Petition to vacate part of Main Street NE located between 19th Ave NE and (vacated) 18th Ave NE, and east of the railroad tracks but west of the property located at 1800 2nd St NE.

**Action:** The City Planning Commission recommended that the City Council accept the findings and approve the vacation (Vacation File 1520) subject to the provision of an easement to the City of Minneapolis for a Bicycle/Pedestrian Trail.
