Subject: APPROVAL OF A GRANT AMENDMENT FROM PILLSBURY UNITED COMMUNITIES

Recommendation

The Police Department requests that the City accept and additional \$4,617 in federal grant funds from Pillsbury United Communities and that the proper city officials be authorized to execute the required contract amendment. The grant amendment provides additional funding for police overtime as deemed necessary to fulfill the goals of the Central Weed and Seed Steering Committee. The Department also requests that the General Appropriation Resolution of 2005 be amended to increase the appropriation in the Federal Grants Special Revenue Fund (0300-400-P300) by \$4,617, and increase the revenue source (0300-400-P300-3210) by \$4,617.
