Augsburg College is seeking an on-sale intoxicating liquor license for itself and any qualifying entity holding a caterer's permit and a contract with Augsburg College to attract diverse events to the campus, increase use of campus event facilities, and provide the highest level of entertainment and food service possible to the campus and greater community. The special legislation was required because Augsburg College is not located on property zoned for regular liquor license approval.

Approving Laws of Minnesota 2009 Legislative Session; Chapter 120, Article 1, Section 14

Whereas the Minnesota State Legislature has passed a law authorizing the City of Minneapolis to issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to Augsburg College, or to any qualifying entity holding a caterer's permit and a contract with Augsburg College; and

Whereas the license authorizes sales on all days of the week.

Whereas, said legislation, by its terms requires an affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the City Council by the first day of the next regular session of the legislature before it may become effective; and

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by the City Council of Minneapolis:

That the said law be now approved and the City Clerk be directed to prepare and file with the Secretary of State the required certification of approval.
