a.	1.0" – 12.5"	5%	per inch	\$ 4.50
b.	12.6" – 20.5	10%	per inch	\$ 7.20
c.	20.6" – 29.5"	30%	per inch	\$15.00
d.	29.6" and over	25%	per inch	\$17.95
e.	Fallen trees and/or branches	30%	per inch	\$18.95

Vendor offers to extend for an additional 12 months and for a second 12 months at the sole option of City of Minneapolis
