Amending Chapter 19, Section 4 of the Minneapolis City Charter relating to Civil Service, to include the director and librarians of the public library as part of the "unclassified service."

The City Council of The City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 19, Section 4 of the Minneapolis City Charter be amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Powers of Commission To Extend Only To Classified Service.

The powers of the commission shall extend only to the classified service which shall embrace the entire service of the City except the following officers, and employees, which shall be known as the "unclassified service", namely: Officers who are elected by the people; members of boards and commissions; the city clerk; secretaries of the several boards and commissions serving without pay; the city engineer; the chief health officer; the Chief of police; the City assessor; superintendents, principals, supervisors of teachers and teachers in the public schools; the city attorney; the attorney of the park board; the ~~librarian and assistants~~ director and librarians of the public library; the superintendent of parks; a landscape architect; a chief of park police; and the Mayor's private secretary. None of the unclassified service shall be subject to examination or affected as to their selection, appointment, discharge or removal by the provisions of this Chapter.
