Dear Mr. Whitfield,

I am denying your Class C Permit Application for bringing 1 elephant, 2 kangaroos, 2 Lemurs and 8 ponies into the City of Minneapolis for an event scheduled at the Minneapolis Convention Center on May 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The denial is based on:

Minneapolis Code of Ordinance 74.65 (m) Minneapolis Animal Care and Control may deny an application for a traveling animal exhibition permit for any of the following reasons:

- 1) Failure to comply with or supply any information or access requested and/or required; or
- 3) Previous or current violations of any provisions of this chapter;

In particular, but not limited to:

- 1) Your application was not filed 90 days prior to the scheduled or planned event in the City of Minneapolis.
- 2) You have not provided pertinent records related to the veterinary care for all of the applicant's animals.
- 3) You have not provided the application filing fee.

If you wish to have this Class C Permit Application Denial reviewed, Minneapolis Code of Ordinances 74.65 (p) provides:

In the event of a permit denial by Minneapolis Animal Care and Control, the applicant may, upon written request, have the denial reviewed by the Public Safety and Regulatory Services Committee (now referred to as the Public Safety, Civil Rights, and Health Committee) of the city council no less than 30 days prior to the scheduled or planned event in the city.

The only applicable Public Safety, Civil Rights and Health Committee Meeting is Wednesday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 1:30pm in Room 315 Minneapolis City Hall. To request a hearing, you must submit written request to the City Clerk's Office no later than 1:00pm, Tuesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
