The current terms to include seven members to be two year terms and six members to have one year terms.


Amend the by-laws to accept two additional positions on the committee that would be reserved for youth. Youth defined as between the ages of 16 and 22.

December 17, 2002, the Latino Advisory Committee voted amend their by-laws to staggered terms because that was the original intent of the committee when it was formed. During this same meeting the committee voted to include two additional seats on the committee to ensure that the voice of youth are well represented on their committee. During the November, 2002 summit, half of the participants were young people.
