Amending Title 2, Chapter 28 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Administration: Department of Inspections.

The City Council of The City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 28.30 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

28.30. Personnel of department. To assist in the administration of the department, the director of inspections shall appoint such assistants as shall be provided by the city council. ~~They shall be appointed and dismissed in accordance with the regulations of the civil service commission.~~ They shall perform such duties as shall be assigned by the director of inspections. They shall devote their entire time to the work of the department and shall not be privately engaged, directly or indirectly, in the work of drawing plans, or in any of the several businesses the operation of which come under the jurisdiction of the department, or in the selling of materials for such operations. They shall receive such compensation as shall be appropriated by the city council.

Section 2. That Section 28.50 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

28.50. Qualifications, duties of director of inspections. The director of inspections shall be an architect, engineer, ~~or~~ builder or municipal attorney, who has been engaged in the active duties of such occupation for at least ten (10) years. The director of inspections shall enforce the building code, the zoning code, the housing maintenance code, as well as all ordinances relating to electric wiring, plumbing, housing and other details of building construction, and all ordinances pertaining to signs, billboards, smoke abatement and such other ordinances as the city council shall direct the director of inspections to enforce. The director of inspections shall appoint, ~~subject to the approval of the civil service commission,~~ all officers and assistants in the department; shall supervise their work and assign their duties; and shall dismiss them when necessary for the public good in accordance with the rules governing the city service. The entire time of the director of inspections shall be devoted to the work of the department, and the director of inspections shall not, during the term of office, be engaged in any private work pertaining to the erection of buildings or the sale of building materials.
