The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute a no-cost contract extension amendment with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Division of Emergency Management for our grant for a new bomb response vehicle.

Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department requests permission for a contract amendment to be signed with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Division of Emergency Management to receive a no-cost extension so we may fully expend the grant award. The production and delivery of the new bomb response vehicle has been delayed, necessitating an extension to the grant period. The new vehicle will be used to transport Bomb Squad personnel and equipment to explosive, bomb, or other hazardous situations.
