HF 2114/SF 1846 have been introduced (March 24, 2009) by Rep. Karen Clark and Sen. Linda Berglin. The bill was referred to the Commerce Committee.

The bill states that the city can issue an off-sale license for the sale of wine or malt liquor at 2225 Lyndale Avenue South. However the bill will need to be amended to identify the correct address as 2309 Lyndale Avenue South.

The bill also includes a local approval clause. A copy of the bill is attached.

- 1.2 relating to alcohol; allowing a special liquor license for the city of Minneapolis.
- 1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.4 Section 1. **MINNEAPOLIS; OFF-SALE.**
- 1.5 Notwithstanding any law, local ordinance, or charter provision to the contrary, the
- 1.6 city of Minneapolis may issue one off-sale liquor license for the sale only of wine as
- 1.7 defined under Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.101, subdivision 29, or malt liquor as
- 1.8 defined under Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.101, subdivision 16, for an establishment
- 1.9 to be located at a development on or about 2225 Lyndale Avenue South.
- 1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
