**Conditions on Temporary
Expansion of Premises

Your license, if granted, will be based on the following conditions:

- 1) The business agrees to provide a dedicated security staff to monitor tent entrances (at least one per entrance and two dedicated mobile walkers) to monitor patron activity and ensure proper identification is checked to ensure all patrons are 21 years old or older, and that no patron is allowed to leave the expansion area or the licensed premises with a container(s) of any kind containing beverage alcohol. No security staff assigned to an entrance or as a mobile walker shall be allowed any other assignment such as bartender, bus tables, trash removal, etc.
- 2) The positioning of port-a-potties will be required to in the parking lot in an area(s) near the tent entrances/exits and other areas to provide toilet services to patrons as they leave the expansion area and parking lot.
- 3) Trash cans will need to be positioned near the tent entrances/exits and other locations throughout the parking lot to minimize the amount of trash leaving the parking lot.
- 4) This event will not be allowed to start, set up for, or be otherwise staged, except for the erection of the tent, on any other day of the week than those specified in the temporary license.
- 5) The applicant will be required to send out a trash collection crew to encompass the area surrounding the licensed premises and tent. The trash collection area will be bounded from 22nd Avenue NE to 3rd Street NE to Lowry Avenue to 4th Street NE back to 22nd Avenue NE., to include trash removal from all of the border streets on both sides as well as both sides of those streets within the boundary. Trash collection will be conducted no later than 10 am the following morning after each day of the event as specified in the temporary license. This condition does not override the Ordinance requirement which states that you must have the 100 feet from your premises cleaned off all trash by 3:00 a.m.
- 6) The applicant is expected to adjust event plans as deemed necessary by the applicant as well as by City Staff in order to address any issues that may arise.
- 7) Noise from the business and vehicles will be kept to a minimum [Mpls. Ord. 389.65]

I have read the conditions listed above. I agree with the conditions and I understand that failure on my part or the part of my company or employees to adhere to these conditions may be cause for future adverse licensing action including but not limited to: denial of any/all remaining days of the temporary license; denial of future temporary expansion license requests; suspension; revocation; possible criminal prosecution and/or denial of my business licenses.

These conditions take effect upon the signing of this agreement and will be in full force and effect for the duration of the temporary license as specified in the application.
