Background/Supporting Information

The operation and maintenance cost for the 50th Street West and France Avenue South Parking Facility (Ewing Lot) for 2008 is \$12,729.81.

In determining the special assessment for the previous years' operation and maintenance, the costs are assessed to the benefited properties based on their land area, with the assessment rate for those properties North of 50th Street West being ½ the rate for those properties South of 50th Street West. For the present special assessment proceeding, the assessment rates calculated to approximately \$0.04 per square foot for properties north of 50th Street West and \$0.08 per square foot for properties South of 50th Street West.

These assessment rates are for the properties that have been in the assessment area since the original construction of the parking facility. The property at 4925 France Avenue South was added to the assessment area beginning with the 2001 cost estimate. This property was residential but is now commercial as it is now a part of the property (developed by Pinehurst) owned by France Partners LLC and is generally located in the Southwestern quarter of the block between 49th and 50th Streets West from Ewing to France Avenue South.

The special assessments would be collected in their entirety on the 2010 real estate tax statement without interest charges.

The Transportation and Parking Services Division of the Public Works department will be utilizing the services of Ampco System Parking for provision of the operation and maintenance work. In working with the neighborhood committee and concerned business owners this some of these services may be provided by other companies in the future. These companies will be under contact with Ampco System Parking.

That the proposed special assessments in the total amount of \$12,729.81 as on file in the Office of the City Clerk be and hereby are adopted and levied upon the benefited properties.

Be It Further Resolved that the special assessments be collected in one (1) installment on the 2010 real estate tax statements without interest charges.

Be It Further Resolved that the assessment roll as prepared by the City Engineer be and hereby is adopted and that the City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of said assessment roll to the Hennepin County Auditor.
