Subject: ACCEPTANCE OF \$74,380 FROM PILLSBURY UNITED COMMUNITIES

Recommendation

The Police Department requests that the City accept \$74,380 in federal grant funds from Pillsbury United Communities and that the proper city officials be authorized to execute the required contract amendment. The grant award provides funding for overtime or other police services as deemed necessary to fulfill the goals of the Central Weed and Seed Steering Committee. The Department also requests that the General Appropriation Resolution of 2008 be amended to increase the appropriation in the Federal Grants Special Revenue Fund 01300-4002300 by \$74,380, and increase the revenue source 321010 by \$74,380.
