Background/Supporting Information

The City of Minneapolis sponsored an application for the Minneapolis Public School's Teenage Pregnancy and Parenting Program (TAPPP). The grant provides funding for comprehensive delinquency prevention programs at the Broadway School for Pregnant and Parenting Teens. Adolescent parents are at high risk for dropping out of school and for actively engaging in criminal behaviors. The overall goal of this program is to provide targeted intervention aimed at increasing school engagement and improving family stability.
