Minnesota GreenCorps is a statewide initiative to help preserve and protect Minnesota's environment while training a new generation of environmental professionals. We are applying for a team of two GreenCorps members – a *Living Green Outreach Specialist* that will work with the Solid Waste/Recycling Division in Public Works and a *Local Food Specialist* that will assist City staff with the Homegrown Minneapolis Initiative.
