Supporting Information: The 2010 calendar for the 2011 budget process follows for the review of the Committee. The Board of Estimate public hearing and meeting to set the maximum property tax levies are tentative dates. As in the 2010 budget process, the 2011 calendar has a tentative date for an unofficial public comment. Mark-up by Ways and Means/Budget Committee and Council adopted budget dates are also tentative.

The City will certify these dates to the County on September 15, 2009, as required by Minnesota Statute. This information will be included on Truth in Taxation notices in November.

Budget adoption must allow for public comment and cannot be scheduled before 6:00 pm.
