Subject Permission to Enter into a Contract with Redeemer Center for Life

Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests permission to correct the city action from October 10, 2003 regarding the St. Phillip's Community Outreach Project. The project is called the St. Philip's/Redeemer Initiative. The Police Department requests permission for the proper city officials to execute the contract agreement with Redeemer Center for Life to accept up to \$104,000 for the Crime Prevention Specialist working with the Initiative for two years. The Police Department requests an amendment to increase the general appropriation resolution for 2003 by the amount of \$104,000. The grant award will operate through the Grants - Federal fund 0300-400-P400, Revenue Source 3210.

Background/Supporting Information

The Minneapolis Police Department requests permission to correct the previous city action from October 10, 2003, approving a grant extension from St. Philip's Catholic Church to continue the detail of a Crime Prevention Specialist for two years. The project is now called the St. Philip's/Redeemer Initiative and funding will be provided by the Redeemer Center for Life. Redeemer Center for Life will provide up to \$104,000 for the Crime Prevention Specialist's salary for two years. The Police Department will pay the fringe benefits for the Crime Prevention Specialist position.
