**Subject Request Permission to Enter into a Contract Agreement for
Liquor Compliance to Reducing Underage Drinking**

Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute a contract agreement from Minnesota Commissioner of Public Safety to accept grant funds to support liquor compliance to reducing underage drinking. The Police Department requests an amendment to increase the general appropriation resolution for 2004 by the amount of \$4,000. The grant award will operate through the federal grant fund 0300-400-C201, Revenue Source 3210.

Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department has received an award of \$4,000 from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety - Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division to address underage drinking in the city. The award will be used in the Second Precinct for enforcement and investigation to address "party houses" in the area of the University of Minnesota.
