**Subject Request Approval to Enter into a Grant Award Contract for the Minnesota Gang Strike Force**

### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute the State Gang Strike Force grant award agreement for an estimated two-year period and requests an amendment to increase the general appropriation resolution for 2006 by the amount of \$320,000. The grant award will operate through the federal grant fund, 0600-400-C007, Revenue Source 3215.
