Subject: Approval to accept the Med-Compass proposal to provide Mobile Health Services for Fire Personnel during the Fire Department's annual "Health Fair".

Recommendation: Approval to accept the lowest bid from Med-Compass in the amount of \$37,075, to provide mandatory annual testing as required by OSHA and the NFPA, for firefighters.

The Request for Proposal, in addition to the required testing for the fire suppression personnel, asked for estimated costs for optional tests that could be included at the annual Fire Department Health Fair.

Based on available funding within the Fire Department budget, we request approval to work with a city attorney on the development of an agreement with Med-Compass for Mobile Health Services, up to \$70,000 for the first year of the agreement, and with the option to renew the agreement for a second and third year.
