Background Information:

The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee advises the Mayor, City Council and City departments on issues related to seniors and acts as liaison with communities and agencies. The Committee has 23 members that are appointed for two year terms. Thirteen represent each ward of the City, and members must be 55 years or older. Ten members represent community service agencies and associations serving residents of Minneapolis, and do not have to be 55 or older and do not have to be residents of Minneapolis. All persons are appointed or reappointed by the Mayor and City Council President and confirmed by the City Council. There is one vacancy in ward 9.
