Minneapolis Public Housing Authority has contracted the Minneapolis Police Department to provide services not to exceed \$660,000 for six patrol officers, one Sergeant to provide safety and protection of the residents in its public housing developments.

### Background/Supporting Information

Since February of 1994 the MPD has been fully operational and this year will consist of six Officers, one Sergeant.. We request approval to enter into the above contract with the Minneapolis Public Housing Authority for the contract to run January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005. The cost will not exceed \$660,000 and will be reimbursed by the Minneapolis Public Housing Authority. We anticipate this revenue and expenditures, they are included in the Minneapolis Police Department's General Fund #010-400.
