## **Supporting Information**

Immediately after the collapse of the 35 W bridge, law enforcement agencies throughout the state responded to the emergency call out for assistance. Nine of these agencies have asked to be reimbursed for their costs during that time. The city submitted their costs as part of their request to FEMA but as yet, we have not received the funding to pay these agencies. Budget Director Johnston has regular conversations with the State Emergency Management staff and has been lead to believe that if the city pays the agencies, we will be reimbursed our costs. (Earlier this year the city was reimbursed for the amount they paid to the St. Paul Police Department for their assistance.) The agencies requesting reimbursement and the amounts are listed below.
