

RESOLUTION 2009R-_____

Authorizing car allowance for each member of the City Council for 2010 through 2013 and setting the salary schedule for 2010 through 2013 for Mayor and Council Members.

Whereas, Laws of Minnesota, 1963, Chapter 727, authorizes the City Council by ordinance to provide for the payment of automobile allowance to any City officer or employee who officially uses his or her own automobile for the performance of public duties, and

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis has authorized the payment of automobile allowances in Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IX; and

Whereas, Laws of Minnesota, 1971, Chapter 744, Section 3, authorizes the City Council by resolution to fix the annual salary of the Mayor and each Council Member prior to the commencement of the term to which the Mayor and Council Member has been elected; and

Whereas, the City Council last set the salary schedule for the Mayor and Council Members on December 23, 2005;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the City Council of the City of Minneapolis:

That for the four-year term commencing January 4, 2010, and ending January 1, 2014, each member of the City Council shall be entitled to either the automobile allowance equal to the Type A automobile allowance provided for in ~~or the automobile allowance equal to the Type B automobile allowance provided for in~~ Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IX.

And Be It Further Resolved, by the City Council of the City of Minneapolis that the salary schedule for the Mayor and each Council Member for the four year term commencing January 4, 2010, and ending January 1, 2014, shall be set in the following fashion: for the initial year of the term and for each succeeding year of the term, the percentage salary increase for the Mayor and each Council Member shall be the average percentage salary increase, inclusive of step increases, of the collective bargaining agreements approved by the City Council in the preceding year.
