**RESOLUTION
of the
CITY OF
MINNEAPOLIS**

Approving the adoption of a consolidated and amended schedule of civil fines for administrative offenses and rescinding prior fine schedules.

Whereas, the City Council has enacted Chapter 2 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances (hereinafter "Code") which establishes an administrative enforcement and hearing process for certain violations of the Code; and

Whereas, Section 2.40 of the Code provides that violations of certain provisions of the Code are administrative offenses that may be subject to the administrative enforcement and hearing process; and

Whereas, Section 2.60 of the Code provides for the imposition of a civil fine for administrative offenses; and

Whereas Section 2.70 of the Code provides that the City Council will adopt by Resolution a schedule of civil fines for administrative offenses;

Whereas previous Resolutions of this Council have established separate fine schedules for administrative offenses enforced by the Divisions of Housing, Licenses and Consumer Services, Police Licensing and by the Police Department; and

Whereas the City Council wishes to amend these schedules and consolidate them into a single schedule of civil fines for all violations of the Code subject to administrative enforcement by any authorized city employee and wishes to establish civil fines for administrative offenses not currently include on any fine schedule;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Minneapolis:

That Resolution No. 2004R-009, entitled "Approving the adoption of an Administrative Enforcement Fine Schedule for violations enforced by Inspectors assigned to the Licenses and Consumer Services Division of the Department of Regulatory Services." passed October 12, 2001, be and is hereby rescinded.

Be It Further Resolved that Resolution No. 2003R-449, entitled "Approving the adoption of an Administrative Enforcement Fine Schedule for violations of Nuisance Ordinances." passed September 26, 2003, be and is hereby rescinded.

Be It Further Resolved that Resolution No. 2004R-009, entitled "Approving the adoption of an Administrative Enforcement Fine Schedule for violations enforced by Officers assigned to the Police Department License Investigation Division." passed January 16, 2004, be and is hereby rescinded.

Be It Further Resolved that Resolution No. 2004R-032 entitled "A resolution giving approval to implement the use of Administrative Adjudication by the Inspections Division for housing code violations, and to establish a fine schedule for violations." passed January 30, 2004, be and is hereby rescinded.

Be It Further Resolved that the proposed fine schedule presented for consideration be adopted, as set forth in Petn No. _____, on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
