
Subject: **Speed Humps at Erie Street SE, Ontario Street SE, and Dartmouth Avenue SE in the Prospect Park Neighborhood (see attached).**

Recommendation:

- 1) Approve an \$11,250 appropriation increase to the Transportation capital budget for the installation of speed humps in the Prospect Park neighborhood. The speed humps are subject to a NRP agreement for reimbursement in the amount of \$11,250 to the Permanent Improvement Fund.
- 2) Amending the 2002 Capital Improvement appropriation resolution for the PW-Transportation Capital Agency in the Permanent Improvement Fund (4100-943-9440) by \$11,250 and increasing the revenue source 3845 (4100-943-9440) by \$11,250 to be reimbursed by the Prospect Park and East River Road Improvement Association (PPERRIA) through NRP.
- 3) Install speed humps for the following:
 - One set of two speed humps on Ontario St SE between Fulton St SE and Dartmouth Ave SE.
 - One set of two speed humps on Erie St SE between Fulton St SE and Dartmouth Ave SE.
 - One speed hump on Dartmouth Ave SE between Erie St SE and Ontario St SE.

Reporting upon the request of Steve Cross, President of the Prospect Park and East River Road Improvement Association (PPERRIA) for the installation of 5 speed humps. One set of two speed humps on Ontario Street NE, one set of two on Erie Street SE and one speed hump on Dartmouth Ave. SE (see attachment). Steve Cross and PPERRIA have worked with the citizens of the neighborhood along with city officials in determining location and types of traffic calming devices needed in the area. The speed humps have been discussed with Council Member Zerby's office and have received verbal approval.

The residents and property owners on the blocks adjacent to the proposed locations for the speed humps have signed petitions to request the installation, and the signatures have been verified. The signatures meet the 65% level on all blocks.

The Erie Street SE and Ontario Street SE speed humps will cost \$4,500 per pair and Dartmouth Avenue SE speed hump will cost \$2,250 for a total of \$11,250 and will be funded by PPERRIA.

We recommend the installation of one set of two speed humps on Ontario St SE between Fulton St SE and Dartmouth Ave SE, one set of two on Erie St SE between Fulton St SE and Dartmouth Ave SE and one speed hump on Dartmouth Ave SE between Erie St SE and Ontario St SE (see attached) subject to funding reimbursement to Public Works from PPERRIA.
