

Adopting the Minneapolis Local Surface Water Management Plan

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis is required to prepare a Local Surface Water Management Plan (LSWMP) in accordance with Minnesota Statute 103B and Minnesota Rules 8410; and

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis is committed to improving the water quality in the lakes, wetlands, and streams; and

Whereas, On June 18th, 2004, Minneapolis Phase I LSWMP was received and filed by City Council.

Whereas, On May 16, 2006, Minneapolis City Council directed Public Works to submit the updated draft LSWMP to Bassett Creek Watershed Management Commission (BCWMC), Minnehaha Creek Watershed District (MCWD), Mississippi Watershed Management Organization (MWMO) and Shingle Creek Watershed Management Commission (SCWMC) for review and approval; and

Whereas, as requested by the watersheds, an extension of review period of 60 days was granted through September 25, 2006; and

Whereas, the SCWMC approved the Minneapolis LSWMP at its July 13, 2006 meeting; the BCWMC approved the Minneapolis LSWMP at its September 21, 2006 meeting; the MWMO approved the Minneapolis LSWMP at its September 19, 2006 Meeting; the MCWD staff recommended conditional approval of the Minneapolis LSWMP at its Oct. 5, 2006 meeting.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Minneapolis: That the Minneapolis City Council hereby adopts the Minneapolis Local Surface Water Management Plan, dated October, 2006.
