Regulatory Services requires that the parking for the downtown staff in the Public Service Center and City Hall who are assigned parking (food inspectors, problem property inspectors, emergency preparedness staff, pool cars, etc.) to be close to their offices and available by skyway. The best rate was found at the Gateway Ramp, where the City appointed staff are also located. Traffic Control is located at the Leamington Ramp, where their vehicles are parked.
