The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2002 to reflect a decrease in the appropriation in Health and Family Support Agency in the Grants-Federal Fund 0300-860-8623-3210 in the amount of \$15,159.10 and an increase to the Police Department Agency in the Grants-Federal Fund 0300-400-C001-3210 in the amount of \$15,159.10.
