Re: Minneapolis Public Housing Officers

Since the 1990's the Minneapolis Public Housing Agency has paid for Minneapolis Police Officers to provide services to their 23,000 residents. Their properties include 40 high rise buildings and 763 scattered site locations throughout Minneapolis. Until this past year, the \$700,000 has paid the salaries of one Sergeant and six patrol officers, their vehicles and other necessary equipment. This year the funding to the MPHA was decreased and they will be able to reimburse only to a level of \$350,000 which will pay for one Sergeant and three patrol officers. While these officers' focus is to work with residents of public housing and the MPHA administration, they respond to other police calls as well. The work they do affects both the neighborhood and the MPHA property.

The attached document shows the activities by the Public Housing Team officers for 2007.
