Sandra Wallick, the principal of SanMar, Inc, 201 East Lake Street, was sent a notice for a License Settlement Conference on February 13, 2009 to consider adverse license action of the On-Sale Beer Class D and Tobacco Dealers licenses at the Round Up Bar, located at 201 East Lake Street. Ms. Wallick agreed that the evidence presented constituted a possibility that her licenses would be revoked and decide to settle the matter as follows.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On 12-0-08, Lead License Inspector Julie Casey conducted an inspection. A 1999 agreement with the City of Minneapolis required security personnel conducting interior and exterior security sweeps. On 12-18-08, there were no security personnel present.
2. On 11-24-08, 12-02-08, 12-11-08, 12-17-08, 1-7-09 and 1-13-09 illegal drugs were allegedly purchased by undercover police informants. As a result of these purchases a search warrant was executed at the Round Up Bar on 1-13-09. During the search, Minneapolis Police allegedly found illegal drugs behind the bar and determined that an employee was the party conducting the drug sales.

CONCLUSIONS

1. The evidence exists that the licensee, SanMar, Inc, dba Round Up Bar, may have violated Minneapolis City Ordinance 259.250 (1) (c) by allowing controlled substances on the licensed premises.
2. Ms. Wallick is directly and vicariously responsible for any violations on the premises, including parking areas, by any employees under Minneapolis City Ordinance 259.250(3).

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Ms. Sandra Wallick, as president of SanMar, Inc., agrees that her business licenses at 201 East Lake Street are withdrawn and surrendered as of midnight April 30, 2009. Ms. Wallick understands that if she does not close her business as agreed, a license revocation and hearing will be held at the Minneapolis City Council for failing to honor this agreement.

Ms. Sandra Wallick, SanMar, Inc, understands that the holding of a business or liquor license in the City of Minneapolis is both a privilege and a responsibility, and, as such, it is understood that there is a minimum standard that shall be met in order to hold such a license. Furthermore, it is understood that a license holder is responsible to ensure that its business operates in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances and regulations. As such, it is understood and agreed that any violation of the above Recommendations shall constitute just and proper cause for the immediate imposition of any agreed upon or stayed penalties. It is further understood that compliance with the above Recommendations is a requirement for continuing to hold a license and that failure to comply with any of these conditions may result in additional adverse license action.

I have read and understand the above findings of fact, conclusions, and recommendations. I agree with their contents and I agree with the above noted Recommendations. I understand that the failure of my business to adhere to this agreement may be cause for further suspension, revocation, or denial of my license. I understand that this report must be accepted and approved by the Minneapolis City Council and Mayor.
