### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute a grant contract from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety, Div. of Homeland Security and Emergency Management for a MPD consultant/planner who works with the Minnesota/Dakotas Analysis Center. The department also requests an amendment to increase the general appropriation resolution for 2007 by \$75,000. The grant award will operate through the grants-other fund, 0300-400-C007, Revenue Source 3210.
