PETITION

FOR TRAFFIC CALMING AT MIDTOWN YWCA

Council Member Schiff and the Corcoran Neighborhood Organization are trying to calm traffic in the neighborhood and need your help!

The corner of 22nd and 31st is dangerous, and the latest accident happened last week. Children from Anishinabe Academy use the Y, creating 400 daily crossings. The Midtown Public Market will open this summer, adding additional pedestrian traffic.

We, the undersigned, request that the Public Works Department make the intersection of 22nd and 31st Street a four way stop.

In addition, we support a flashing crosswalk between the YWCA and Anishinabe Academy to allow children using the YWCA a safe crossing.

Gary,

Here are my thoughts on the Midtown Market/YWCA stopsign request referenced in your message below. I live across from Bancroft Elementary near 39th St and 14th Ave S. Bancroft is one of the few elementaries (only in my experience) in Minneapolis that is not ringed by four-way stops on non-arterial streets.

About four years ago I called Public Works about getting four-way stops placed at the two 39th St intersections around the school. I think I spoke with Doug Maday then, who oversees traffic flow and signals citywide. If it wasn't Doug, it was someone who was of the same Public Works-Traffic thinking your request has been stymied by. He told me that requests for stopsigns are now carefully scrutinized to prevent situations like parts of Corcoran neighborhood with stopsigns at every block that cause people to roll through them.

To my driving experience, Corcoran is generally quite filled with stopsigns, while much of Ward 12 is not. To me, that explains the disparity in success of new stopsign requests. PW-Traffic wants to be sure stopsigns increase safety by being placed where they will be obeyed, and control traffic flow enough to insure pedestrian safety. I suggest working with Corcoran neighbors to find some stopsigns to remove (perhaps along 34th St?), so that Public Works-Traffic division would be more willing to create a four-way stop at the much busier 31st St - 22nd Ave intersection.

Just my advice. I never pursued stopsigns at Bancroft - hoping that additional traffic control there might come out of the Walking School Bus initiative. That hasn't happened yet, but my school-patrol-member sons have told me about a couple ped-vehicle near misses at 38th St - 14th Ave intersection. I think Bancroft School's School Patrol coordinator has the specifics recorded. Until Bancroft gets more traffic control, I hope it's guardian angel stays on the job.

This is another example of some of the needed changes in Public Works operation I hope Klara addresses soon. Good luck.




