**Subject: Request Approval to enter contract for Automatic Traffic Law Enforcement Systems**

The Police Department requests council approval to enter in a contract with Redflex Traffic Systems for services and equipment to implement the City's Automatic Traffic Law Enforcement System (red-light cameras).
