Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department requests permission to execute a no-cost contract amendment from the MN Dept of Public Safety – Div. of Homeland Security and Emergency Management under the federal 2005 Homeland Security Grant Program. The grant funds are used for a MPD consultant/planner who works with the Minnesota/Dakotas Analysis Center, a statewide and regional intelligence analysis center created by the Minnesota Information Sharing and Analysis Center and the FBI.
