All this work including furnishing and delivering all material, labor, equipment and incidentals necessary to accomplish the work of Contract Category 16, Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment, all in accordance with the plans, specifications and addenda prepared by Architectural Alliance and titled "Minneapolis Central Library Bid Package No. 8 – Contract Category No. 16, Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment for a total contract price of \$ 49,261.00. Terms are net 30 days. F.O.B.: Site. Background/Supporting Information

In November 2000, the citizens of Minneapolis approved a referendum in the amount of \$110 million for the purpose of building a new Minneapolis Central Library on the site of the current Central Library building. On October 25, 2002, the City Council approved the Schematic Design and Budget for the new Library, authorized the Project Coordinator to proceed with design development and requested the Board of Estimate and Taxation to sell \$110 million in bonds authorized by the referendum. On October 25, 2002, the City Council also accepted the low bid of F.M. Frattalone for deconstruction of the existing library.

The bids for Bid Package Number 8, Contract Category Number 16, Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment were opened on September 27, 2005, at 10:00 a.m. and Architectural Brass was the apparent low bidder for the items referenced in the attached letter dated 10/17/05 from Architectural Alliance.

The Project Office and the Architect reviewed the bids and determined that the recommended bidder is both responsive and responsible.

On the basis of the bids received and opened on September 27, 2005 at 10:00am local time, for Official Publication #6511, Bid Package #8 – Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment, Contract Category #16 – Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment, Architectural Alliance is able to make the following recommendation. Based on the bid tabulation certified by the City of Minneapolis, our review of the bids, Architectural Alliance has determined that the lowest responsive and responsible bidder is **Architectural Brass** located at 1130 D.L. Hollowell Parkway, Atlanta, Georgia (404-351-0594).

We recommend award to **Architectural Brass** for the Bid based on the following criteria:

- **Architectural Brass** was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the following items:
- Group 12 Reading Room Patron Waste Baskets WB-1. The Bid amount of \$12,257.00 is below Architectural Alliance's estimate.
- Group 13 Recycling and Waste Receptacles – Public Areas WA-1, PA-1, PG-1. The Bid amount of \$37,004.00 is below Architectural Alliance's estimate.

Architectural Alliance hereby recommends that the City award a contract for this work to **Architectural Brass** in the amount of Forty-nine Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-one Dollars and no/100 (\$49,261.00).
