Tuesday, 4/18, regarding Assessments for people along the 35W construction. I checked the
City of Mpls website and it said 9:45am and had another publication stating 9:15am. Do you

Also, I am opposed for the select few taxpayers on the frontage roads that will be
affected to be assessed for the roads that just happen to be in front of our houses. The
only reason 2nd Avenue, which I live on, is being done is because of the 35W construction.
