The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2003 to decrease Federal Grant Special Revenue Fund, 0300-400-P608, revenue source 3210, in the amount of \$29,000 and increase Federal Grant Special Revenue Fund 0300-860-8600 by \$29,000.

Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department requests permission to amend the general appropriation for 2003 to move grant funding received from the U.S. Department of Justice - Office of Justice Programs, FY 2001 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant program from the Police Department to the Minneapolis Employment and Training (METP). The Police Department administers the city's grant that includes \$100,000 for community crime prevention initiatives. Of this total, \$29,000 will be transferred to support the STEP UP program.
