**BUSINESS
OPERATING
CONDITIONS**

Your Grocery and Tobacco licenses, if granted, will be based on the following conditions:

- 1) The business agrees not to sell items which are commonly used by drug users and drug dealers. These items include glass pipes (sometimes with roses inside), single hollowed-out cigars sometimes referred to as blunts, Brillo Pads or Chore Boys, and small zip lock bags, also known as jewelry bags. The business also agrees not to supply matches to non-tobacco customers.
- 2) All windows will be free of signs and other items that block the view in and out, per Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Chapter 543.350.
- 3) The licensee shall comply with the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Chapter 259.230, governing surveillance cameras, which states that all new business applicants for grocery stores and tobacco dealers must immediately install surveillance cameras.
- 4) The licensee will provide formal training to all staff on how to avoid sales of tobacco products to minors.
- 5) The licensee agrees not to install pay phones in, on or attached to the premise property.
- 6) The licensee shall clean the premises of litter and trash daily, including the area within 100 feet of the property line and dumpster area, per Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Chapter 259.125.
- 7) The business agrees to post Minneapolis Police "No Trespassing" signs, available at the 5th Precinct SAFE Unit. Staff will call 9-1-1 to report loiterers refusing to leave the immediate area.
- 8) The licensee agrees to display a copy of these conditions alongside the business license certificate, clearly visible to customers and inspectors.
