**The licensee currently has a Class A on-sale liquor license. At the time that this license was granted, the licensee completed a Class A License Addendum wherein it was agreed that the licensee would refrain from the presentation of adult entertainment as a condition of continued licensure. The applicant now requests that the business plan now be amended to permit adult entertainment as defined in the Minneapolis Zoning Code Appendix, Section 3. The office of the Zoning Administrator has certified that the premise is properly zoned for such use and that it is also located a greater distance than is required from any qualifying church, school or daycare center. Furthermore, there are no other adult entertainment uses on the block face on which the premise is located.**

**Attached are a License Addendum Agreement wherein the licensee agrees to certain limitations of adult entertainment activities, an amended business plan and the licensee's letter requesting the amendment.**
