REGARDING: Amendment to the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances regarding operating hours of "On Sale" 3.2% Beer licensees.

On Wednesday, September 14, 2005 at 1:30 PM or shortly thereafter, the Public Safety and Regulatory Services Committee of the Minneapolis City Council will consider the following amendment to the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances:

An amendment to Title 14, Chapter 368.60 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to the times when "on-sale 3.2% beer establishments may make sales of beverage alcohol to the public. A recent amendment to Minnesota Statutes deleted the restriction that no "on-sale" of 3.2% beer may be made between the hours of 2:00 AM and 12:00, Noon on Sunday. Should the proposed ordinance amendment be adopted, Minneapolis licensed "on-sale" 3.2% beer establishments shall have the option of selling, serving and permitting the consumption of 3.2% beer at 10:00 AM on Sunday. All other hours of operation restrictions remain unchanged.

You are invited to be present at the public hearing to express your opinion or inform this office of your approval or disapproval of the proposed ordinance amendments in writing.
