Subject PERMISSION TO ACCEPT THE STATE JUVENILE JUSTICE TITLE GRANT

Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute the Juvenile Justice Title Grant award from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety - Office of Justice Programs and execute the required contract agreements. The Department also requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2005 in the amount of \$43,000. The grant award will operate in 2005 in Grant Special Revenue Fund 0300-400-E017, Revenue Source 3210, with federal funds passed through the state agency.

Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department requests permission to accept a Juvenile Justice Title Grant award from the Minnesota Department of Economic Security for up to \$43,000. The grant award will fund the sub-recipient Minneapolis Police Athletic League to reduce juvenile delinquency through recreational and academic program activities. The program will run for 2005. A local match of \$21,500 will be made by the Minneapolis Police Athletic League.
